Car Prices:

Vehicles in NZ are some of the most well priced in the world.

Entry level pricing can be inexpensive ranging in cost from \$1,000 through to \$10,000 for an average family car. Late model low mileage cars however can be far more expensive

Car Registration (Annual Fee) **\$200.10**

Warrant of Fitness **\$30**

Car Insurance ranges from \$300 to \$1,500 per annum – dependant on make and model.

Sports facilities: Many sports facilities in NZ are subsidized such as free swimming pools.

Sporting clubs such as Rugby, Soccer, Hockey, Running etc have annual fees of around \$250 p/a

NZ has youth sailing programme in many centers

With one of the worlds best outdoor environments for trekking/tramping climbing etc, NZ has a network of hundreds of back country huts that cost on average \$10 per night.

Boating and sailing in NZ are affordable activities for most New Zealanders. Smaller craft range from \$7000 second hand to vessels of substantial value. Launching a boat in NZ is either free or via minimal donation for the boat ramp. Mooring costs at marina's for larger craft however can be costly at approximately \$100 per week or above for larger vessels. Swing moorings can be obtained at relatively minimal cost.

Snow skiing: approximately \$400 per person per weekend

Motels: approximately \$50 to 140 per night.

Camping: Approximately \$13 per night for each adult and \$7.00 for children.

Marginally more expensive for caravans and campers.

Fishing: there are many fishing tour operators in NZ which provide fishing tours for between \$50 and \$90 per day. Longer trips and big game fishing however can be very expensive.

Hair cuts, Men's approximately \$20. Woman's from \$50 and above.

Doctors fees: Adult \$45 Child \$25: Booking an appointment with a doctor in NZ is as simple as making a phone call. In most cases doctors in NZ are able to see you immediately or the same day.

Medicals for immigration: \$365 per person. The can also be obtained in most cases within 24 hours.

Fish and Chips \$7.00 for each person

Average cost of a Mc Donald's meal\$7.00

Electricity: An average of approximately \$90 per month

Water: An average of approximately \$100 per annum. NZ water quality is in most cases world leading.

Parking in the central city: approximately \$14 per day

Restaurants: a reasonable restaurant providing a dinner for two are available from \$45 to \$100 approximatley
